RULES & INFORMATION: American System of Judging

UNLIMITED ENTRIES PER EXHIBITOR PER CLASS – see Local Rules (p 5)

- All entries in these Divisions must be home prepared by the Exhibitor.
- Each entry must be from a separate batch.
- Baked foods must be delivered on sturdy paper plates, Styrofoam, or cardboard forms.
- Small baked food items must be delivered in clear zip-lock bags.
- Quantities as listed in Division titles.
- **NEW! Charcuterie:** All entries must arrive covered in plastic wrap. Use items that are safe at room temperature. Entry must include a photo, minimum size of 8" x 10", of finished board to be displayed during the fair. Entries will be consumed after judging. Board may be picked up during release times. Please label your board with name and phone number on the bottom. Boards do not have to include meat; may include vegetables, fruit, cheese, crackers, nuts, etc.

ENTRY FEE: \$1 per entry

AWARDS OFFERED PER CLASS: 1st Place - \$3 and Ribbon; 2nd Place - \$2 and Ribbon; 3rd Place - \$1 and Ribbon
