**AGE:** 18 years and older

**RULES & INFORMATION:** American System of Judging

UNLIMITED ENTRIES PER EXHIBITOR PER CLASS – see Local Rules (p 5)

### **HOME GROWN FRUIT & VEGETABLES:**

- The quality desired in agriculture and horticulture exhibits is the quality that brings the best financial return in the commercial market.
- Horticulture exhibits must have been grown by the Exhibitor at least three (3) months prior to the Fair.
- All exhibits should be in a mature state and not overripe.
- The exhibit should be uniform commercial size, rather than overgrown.
- Exhibits must be clean and free of dirt and insects.
- Exhibits should be attractively arranged in a suitable container.

### **GARDEN PROJECTS:**

- Outdoor Garden is to be planted in a wheelbarrow, garden cart or small wagon. Container must be pre-planted and contain a minimum of 5 varieties of plants to be eligible. Plants should be labeled.
- Miniature Garden must contain at least 3 varieties of plants to be eligible.
- Glassware, buckets, pails, mining pans, etc., used for display provided by Exhibitor.

### **COMPOSTING:**

- Entries must be submitted in a 1-gallon size clear, resealable food storage bag.
- Compost to be made from household and yard waste. Indicate what kinds of household and yard waste was used.
- Submit a photo of your compost bin and a brief description of your technique (cold, warm, worm, etc.).

### **NATURE'S ODDITIES:**

- Fruit/Vegetable products that deviate from market size or type, which are unusual in size, shape or color.

**ENTRY FEE:** \$1 per entry

**AWARDS OFFERED PER CLASS:** 1<sup>st</sup> Place - \$3 and Ribbon; 2<sup>nd</sup> Place - \$2 and Ribbon; 3<sup>rd</sup> Place - \$1 and Ribbon

### **SPECIAL AWARDS:**

**Best of Show – Adult Fruits and Vegetables:** Ribbon and \$25 cash premium

**Best Fair Theme – Garden Projects, Class 6:** Ribbon

### **DIVISION 136 GARDEN PROJECTS**

- CLASS
1. Outdoor garden (Wheelbarrow, garden cart, or small wagon)
  2. Kitchen garden in a Container (Salsa garden, pizza garden, herbs, salad, etc.)
  3. Miniature garden (Bucket, pail, tea cup, etc.)
  4. Unusual or novelty planter (Colander, boot, mining pan, etc.)
  5. Imagination/Fairy garden
  6. Any project using Fair Theme – *Comin' In Hot!*
