UNLIMITED ENTRIES PER EXHIBITOR PER CLASS – see Local Rules (p 5)

- The quality desired in agriculture and horticulture exhibits is the quality that brings the best financial return in the commercial market.
- Horticulture exhibits must have been grown by the Exhibitor at least three (3) months prior to the Fair.
- All exhibits should be in a mature state and not overripe.
- The exhibit should be clean and free of dirt and insects.
- Exhibits should be attractively arranged in a suitable container.

ENTRY FEE: \$1 per entry

AWARDS OFFERED PER CLASS: 1st Place - \$3 and Ribbon; 2nd Place - \$2 and Ribbon; 3rd Place - \$1 and Ribbon
